## Guest Speakers


Viv Blycha Army Art

Army Art is a charity event that showcases existing and emerging West Australian artists and raises money for Western Australian charities. The event is currently held at Leeuwin Barracks, East Fremantle in August of each year and draws a crowd of over 1000 people through opening night and weekend attendance.


Our first exhibition in 1974 was held at the Special Air Service Regiment (SASR) at Campbell Barracks in Swanbourne. The event organisers at that time (the SASR Ladies Auxiliary) could not have known that they would begin an event that would see it become one of Perth's leading fundraising cultural art events. We have always attracted an impressive list of people to open our exhibition each year, from Governor Generals, Federal Ministers and the wives of Prime Ministers to the CEO of mining giants and sporting stars. Army Art continues to be well regarded and supported, a testament to our professionalism and success. Now in our 42nd year of operation, we remain as committed as ever to achieving our aims and we look forward each year to discovering new artists and being able to provide them with an opportunity to showcase their talents.


Funds raised from the event go to a selected not for profit charity





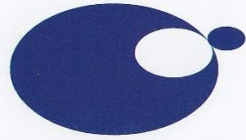
