Raffle was drawn by STEP student Charlotte and won by Ted Evans

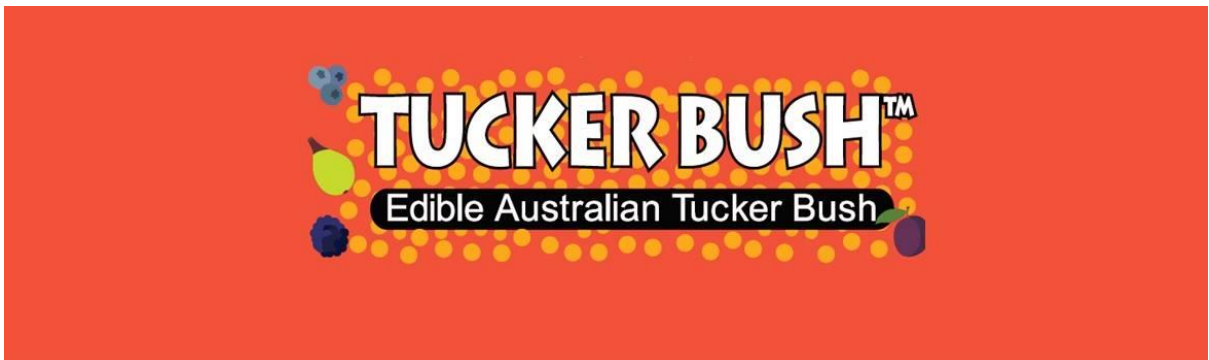
Some of the fines
