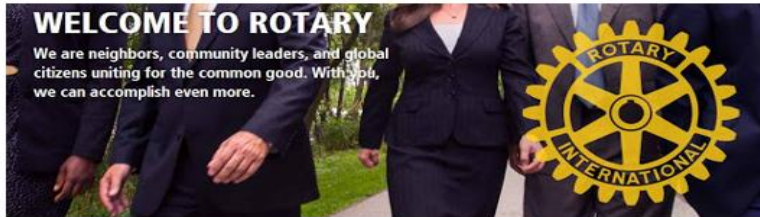

John Stockbridge introduced Nick Abraham from SWALSC

WALSC is a Native Title Service Provider to the Noongar People

The South West Aboriginal Land and Sea Council (SWALSC) are a native title service provider to the Noongar people, who are the traditional owners of the south west of Australia. SWALSC works with members to progress the resolution of Noongar native title

claims, while also advancing and strengthening Noongar culture, language, heritage and society.

Nick has reluctantly become an elder for his tribe since the passing of his farmer
The noongar tribe has lived in SW Western Australia peacefully for the last 45.000 years
Since 2006 has negotiating with Governments and courts for Native title to their land
In July 2015 the state government made an offer
This was rejected by several people
And although they signed an agreement in 2015
There were still objections
In November this year another hearing is scheduled in the Federal court
And they are hopeful of a decision in April 2020
Nick invited members to read from the screen excerpts of happenings and this gave
members the opportunity to understand the native title process

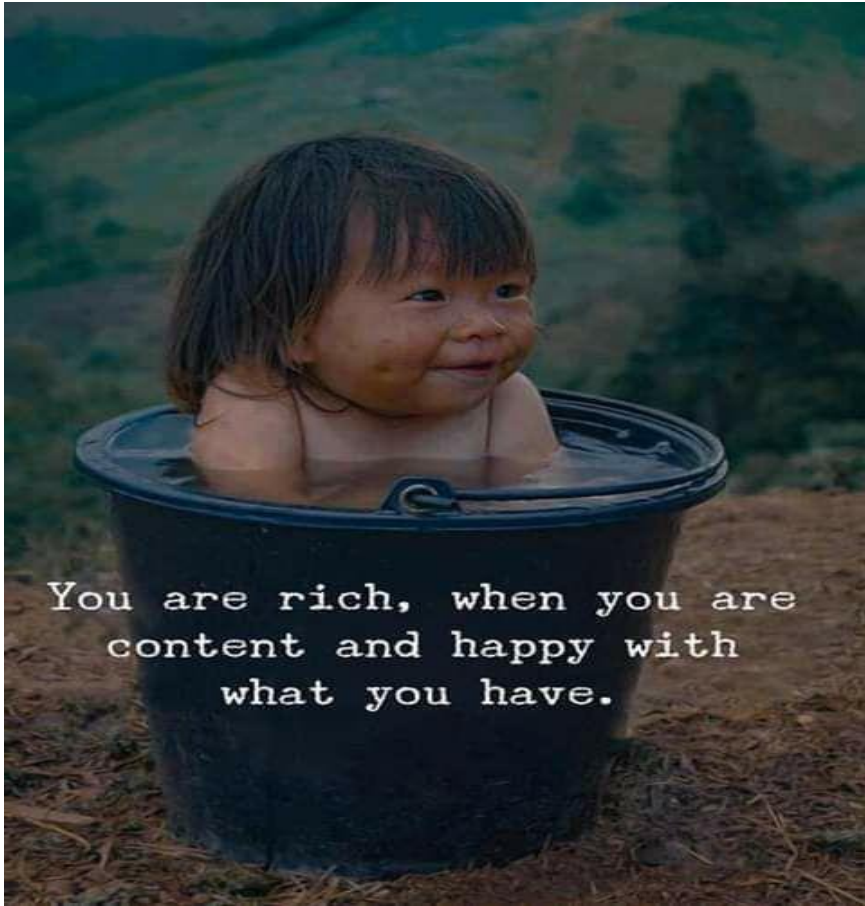
