Carlton got the nickname "Tommy" from his grandmother in reference to Tom Thumb



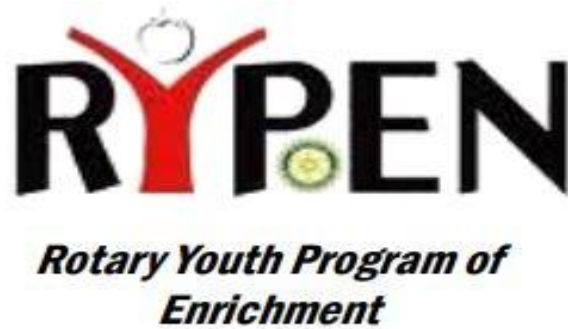

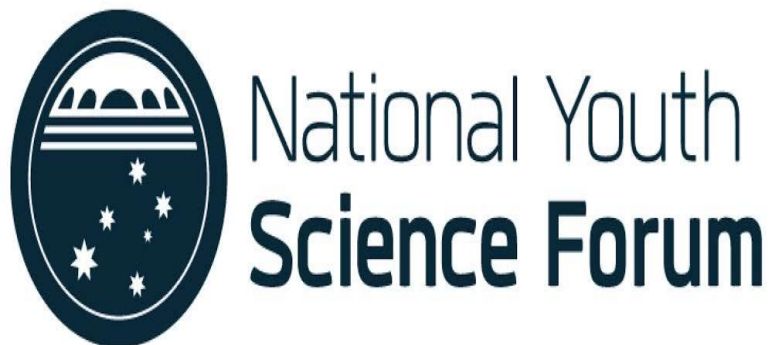
