Viv is on the Executive Committee of Birdlife WA
the organisation is helping with the conservation of all birds
Viv took members thru a fascinating slide show of WA birds and their calls



Almost 550 species of birds have been recorded in Western Australia.

387 species have been recorded breeding.

17 species are endemic to Western Australia.

These are Carnaby's Black-Cockatoo, Baudin's Black-Cockatoo, Western Corella, Western Rosella, Red-capped Parrot, Noisy Scrub-bird, Red-winged Fairy-wren, Black Grass wren, Western Bristlebird, Dusky Gerygone, Western Thornbill, Western Wattlebird, Kimberley Honeyeater, Western Spinebill, White-breasted Robin, Western Ground Parrot and Red-eared Firetail . Many other species have unique sub species in Western Australia such as Western Whipbird, Crested (Western) Shrike-tit and Lemon-bellied (Kimberley) Flycatcher.
