Ric and Ailsa are planning to take Noemie north to Karajina and Exmouth and Coral bay before she hopes to head home early in July

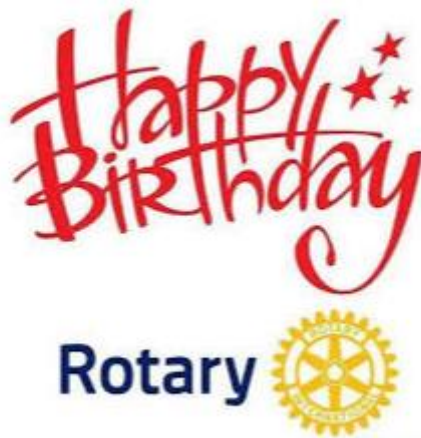
Much general discussion took place amongst members regarding the Bring and Buy Markets and upcoming possible club projects

With some dollars been collected



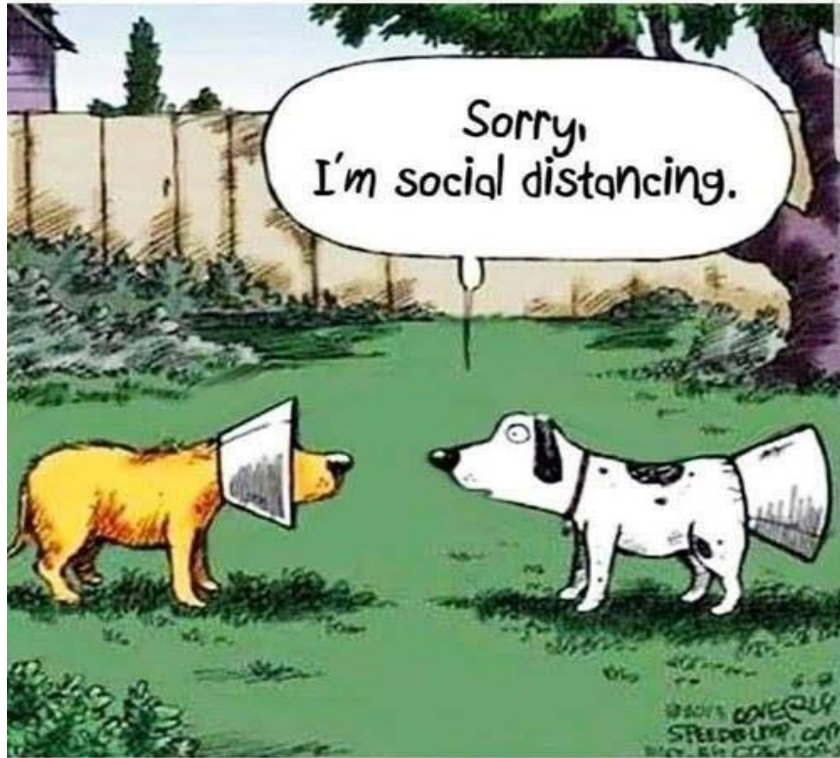
