Everyone was caught out and paid for it

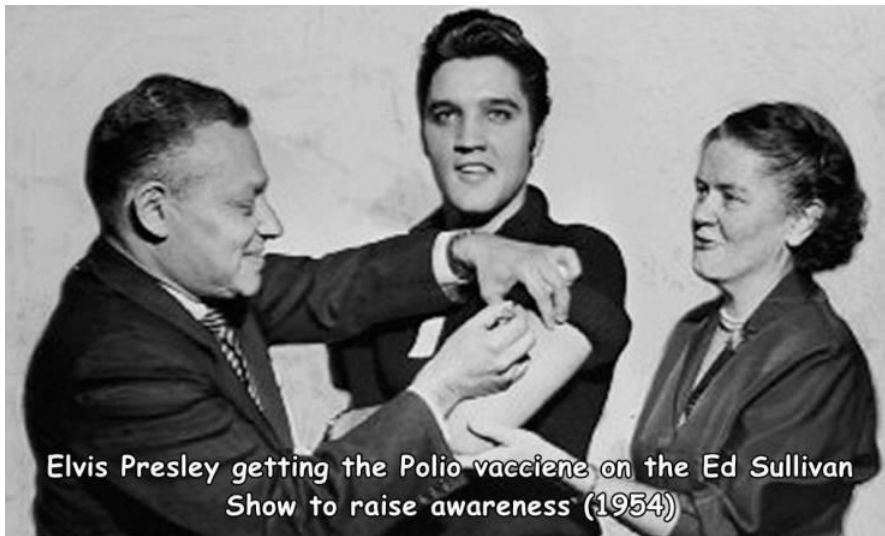
All members not wearing a Rotary pin were fined
