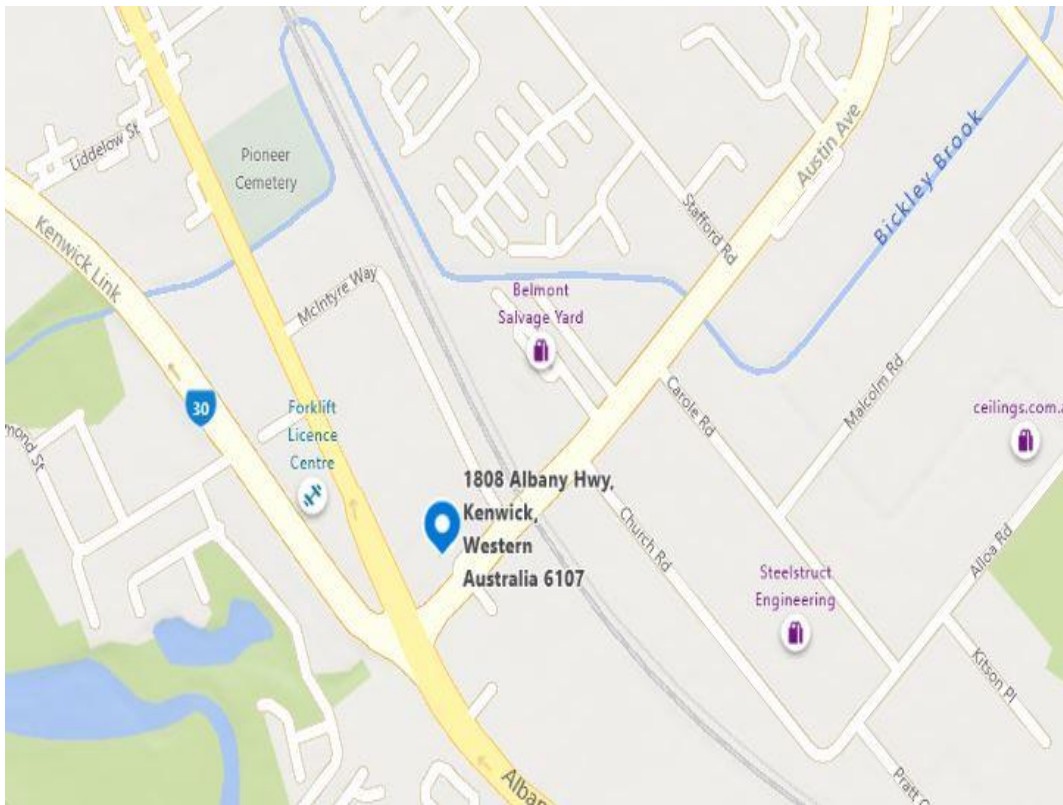

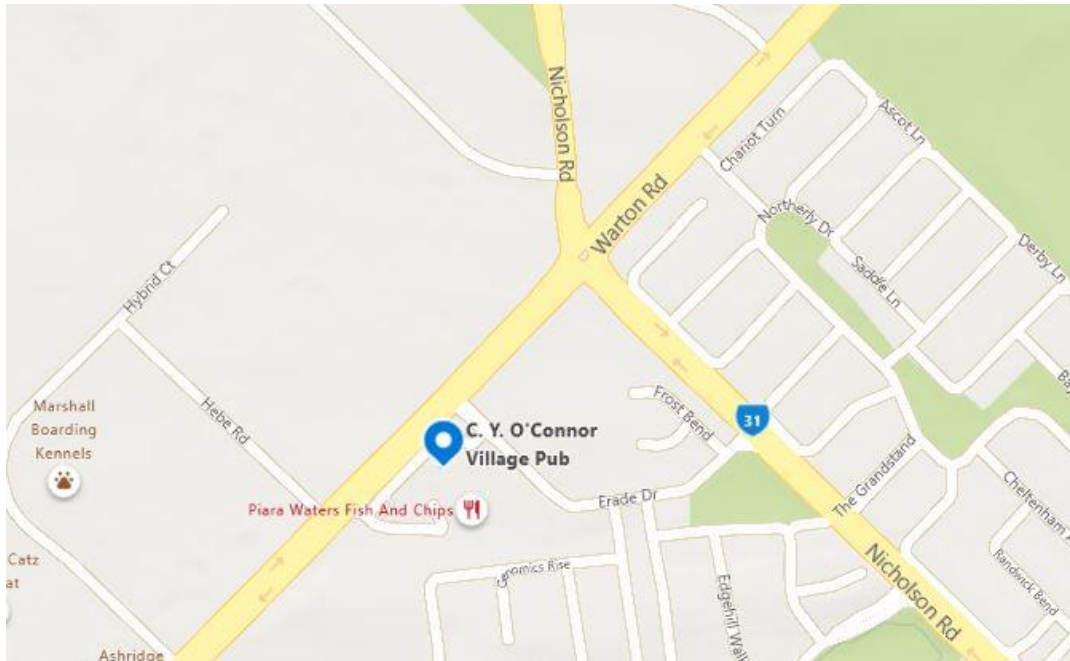

At present 16 members are attending



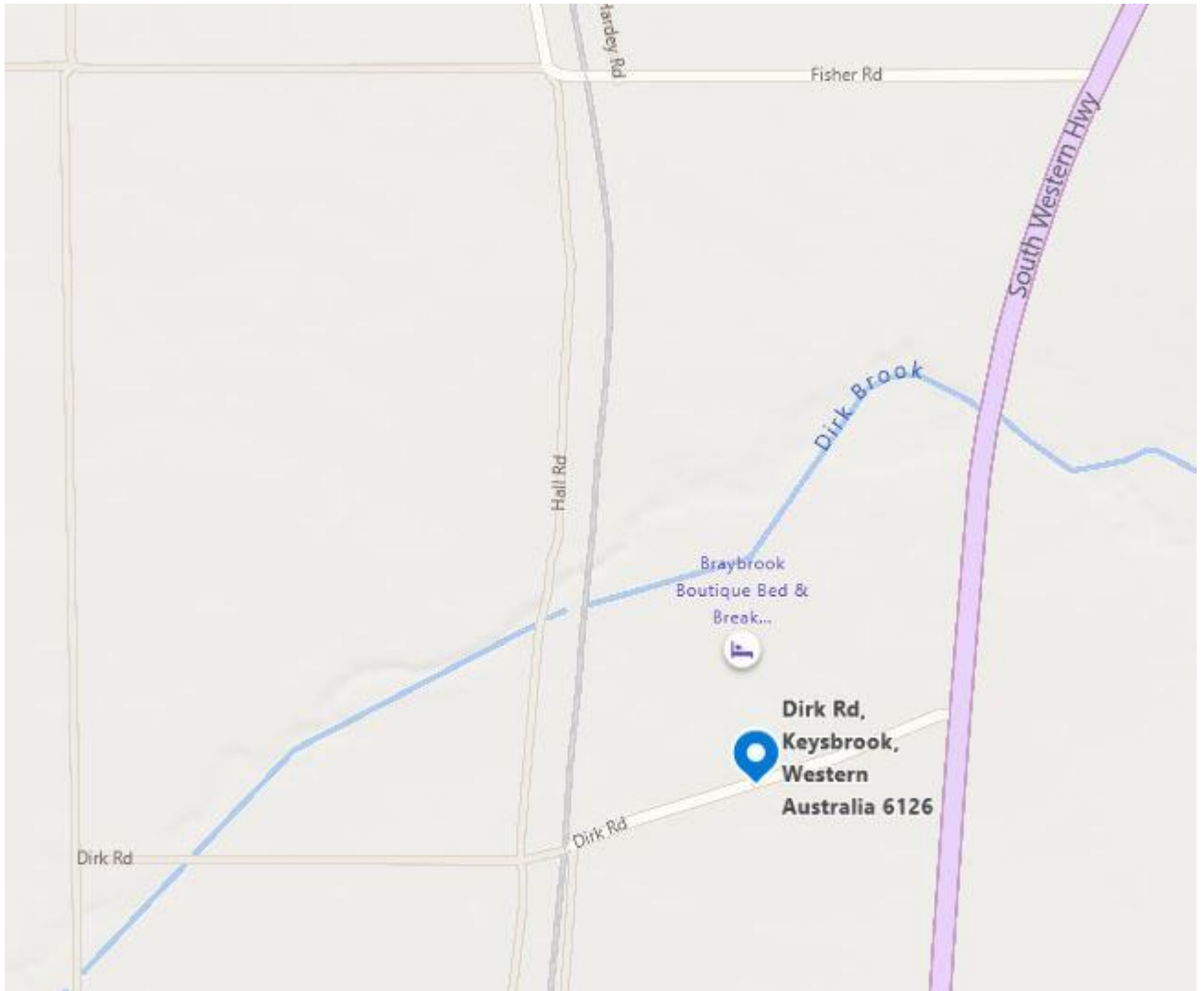


This is a club meeting night
