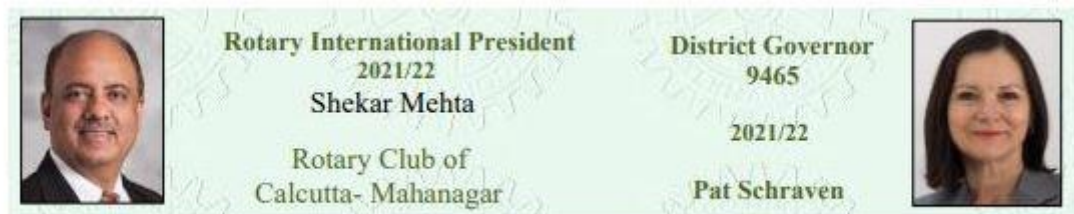




Notes from the meeting 2021/2022

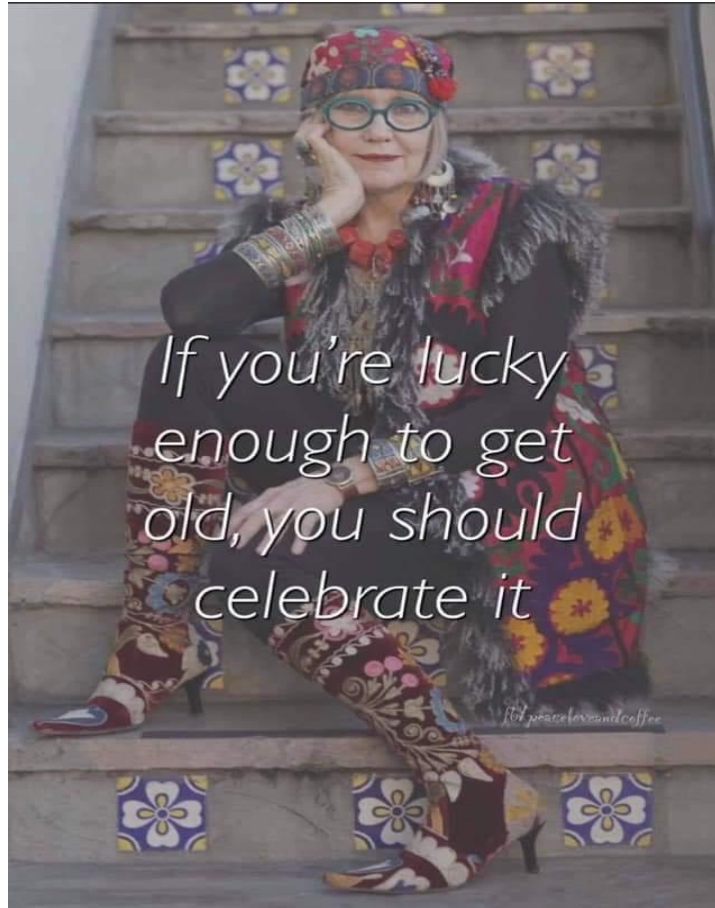
**Gone Are the Days
