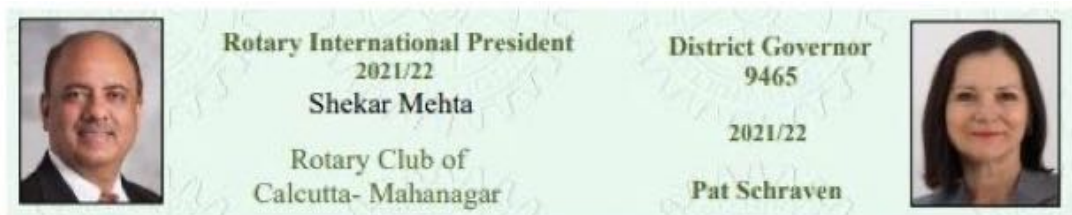

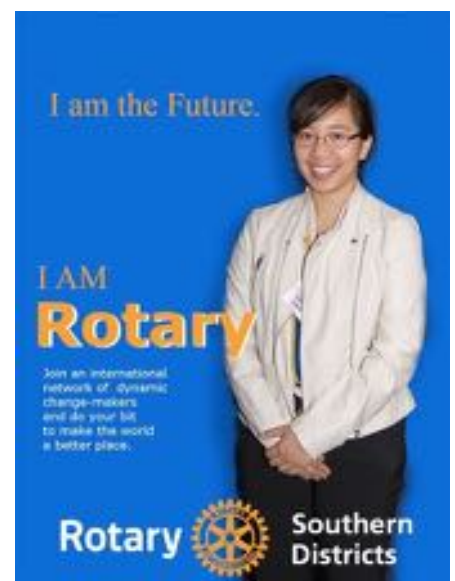


Report From President Phil

Fred is having a snooze

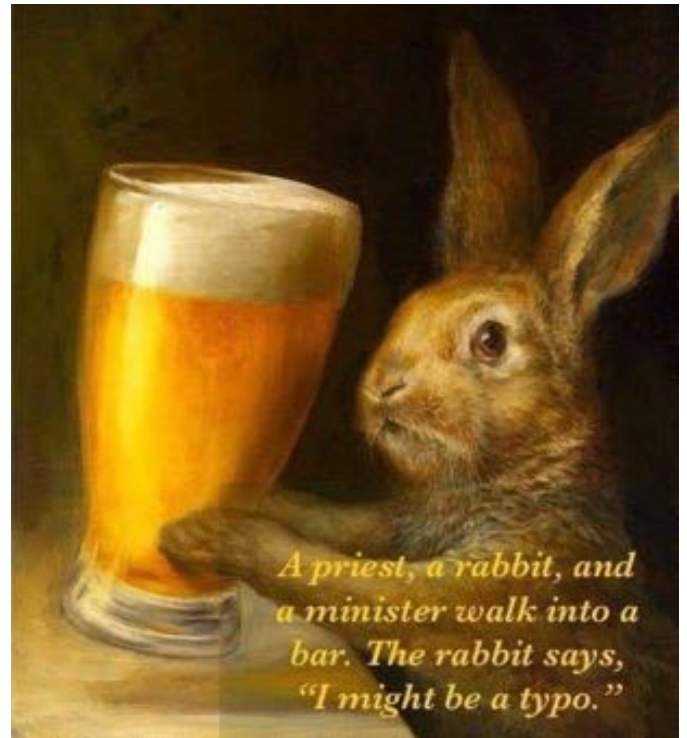
