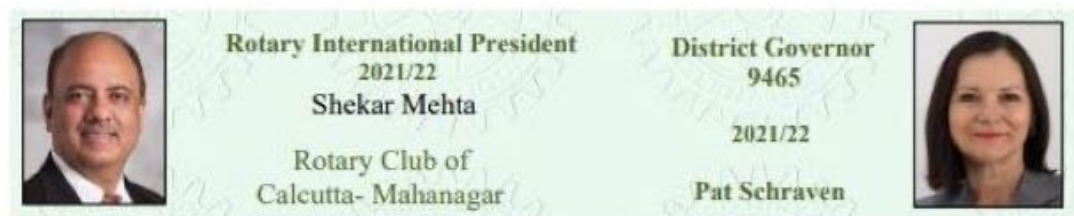




Meeting Notes & News 2021/22

Coffee shortage notwithstanding, last week Team 1 collected a solid \$ 1 730



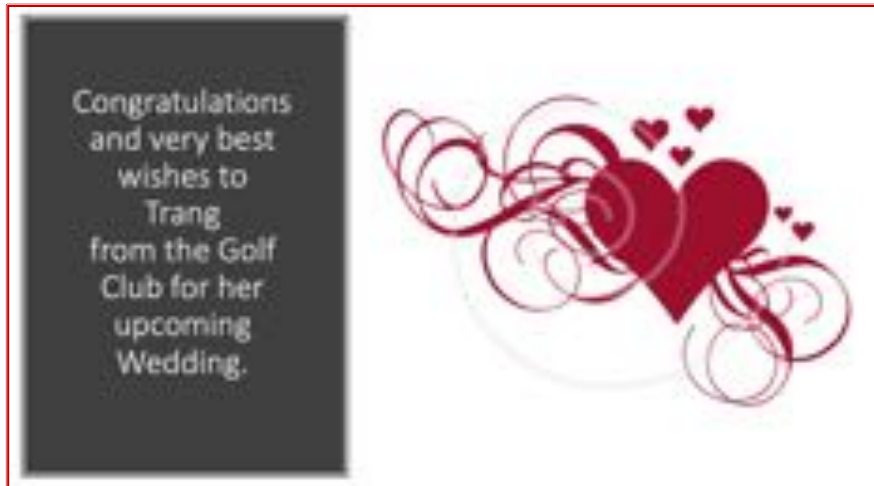
