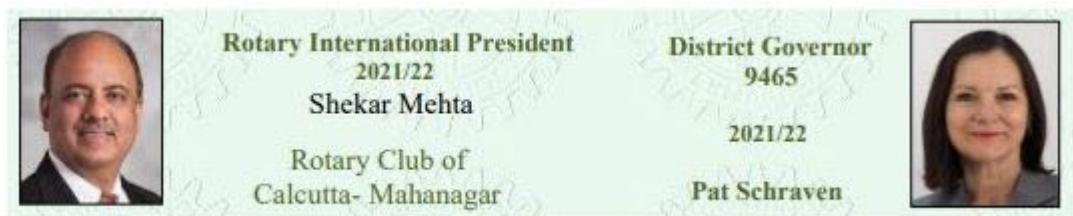




Meeting Notes & News 2021/22

This year, the activities included flying fox, sea biscuiting, fishing, sailing, games nights, karaoke, ten-pin bowling and visits to the Zoo and Adventure World. All participants are sponsored by a Rotary Club in the District, for their accommodation, meals, and activities.

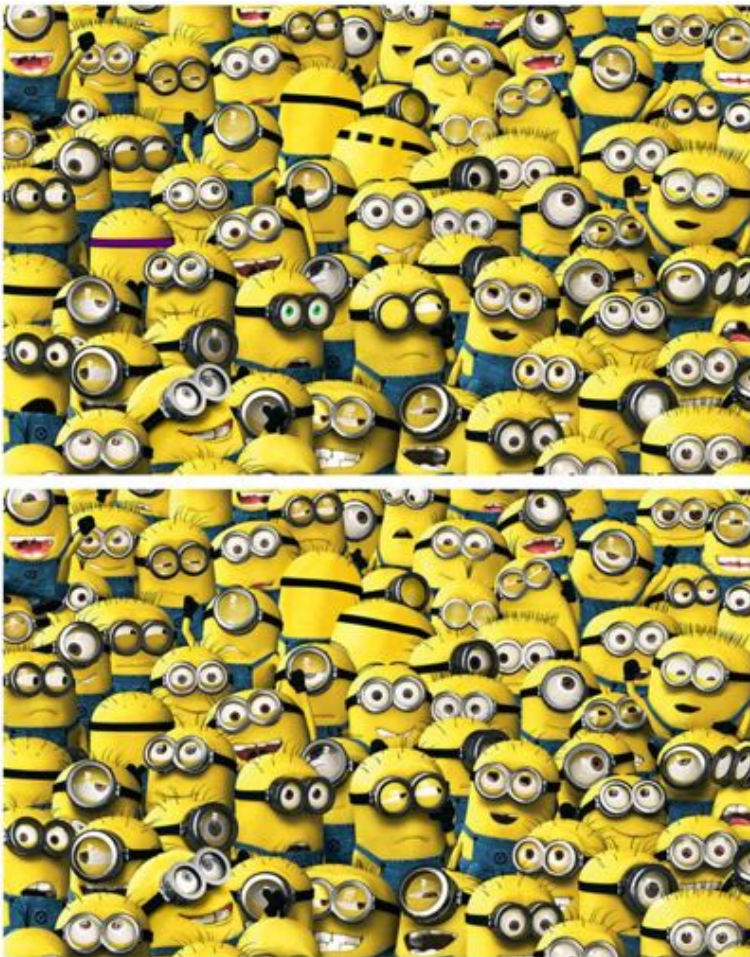
Did you know?

How many differences can you find between these two pictures?

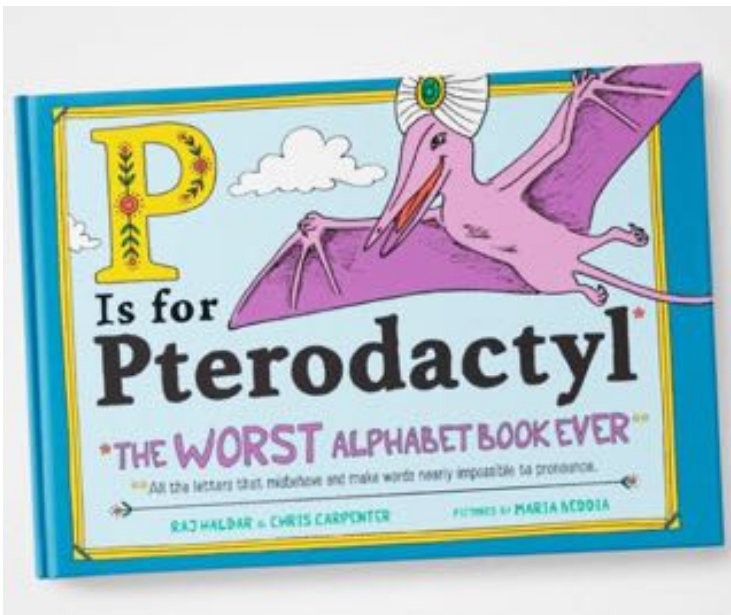
