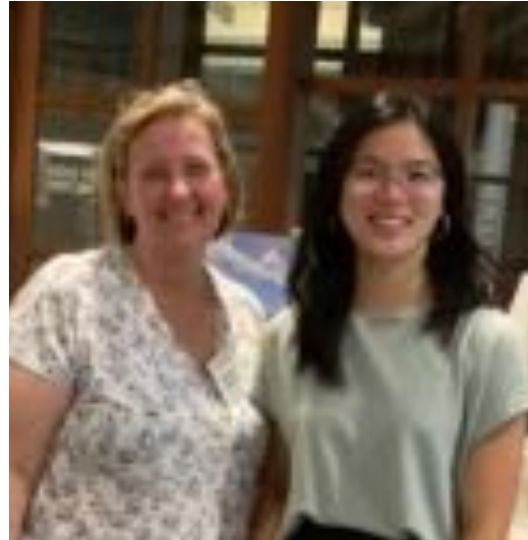
Meeting Highlights

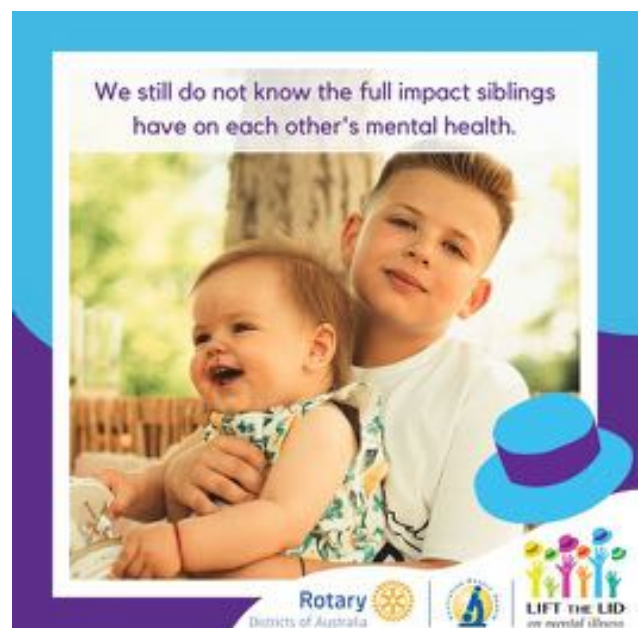
