A reminder that our visit to the Austrian Club is coming up *this* Sunday, 22 January.

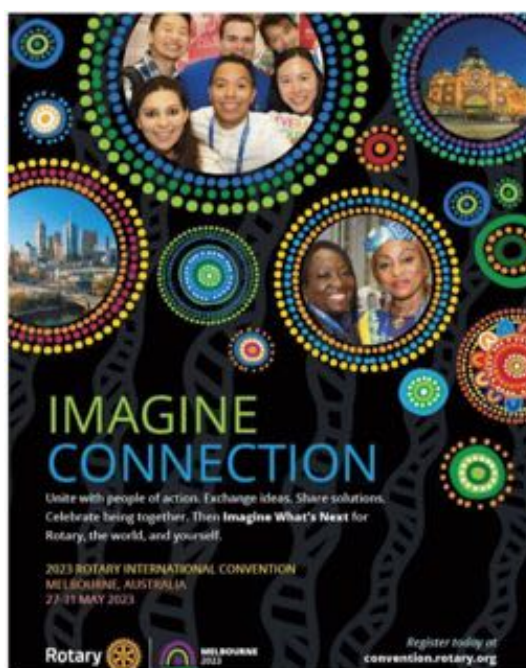
**Time:** 4pm onwards
